- To establish an interdenominational epicenter for evangelism, disciple making, and church planting in South Central Asia.

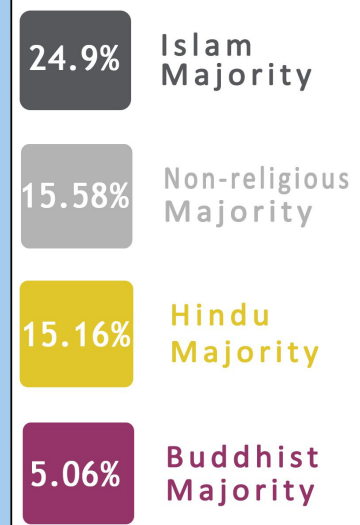
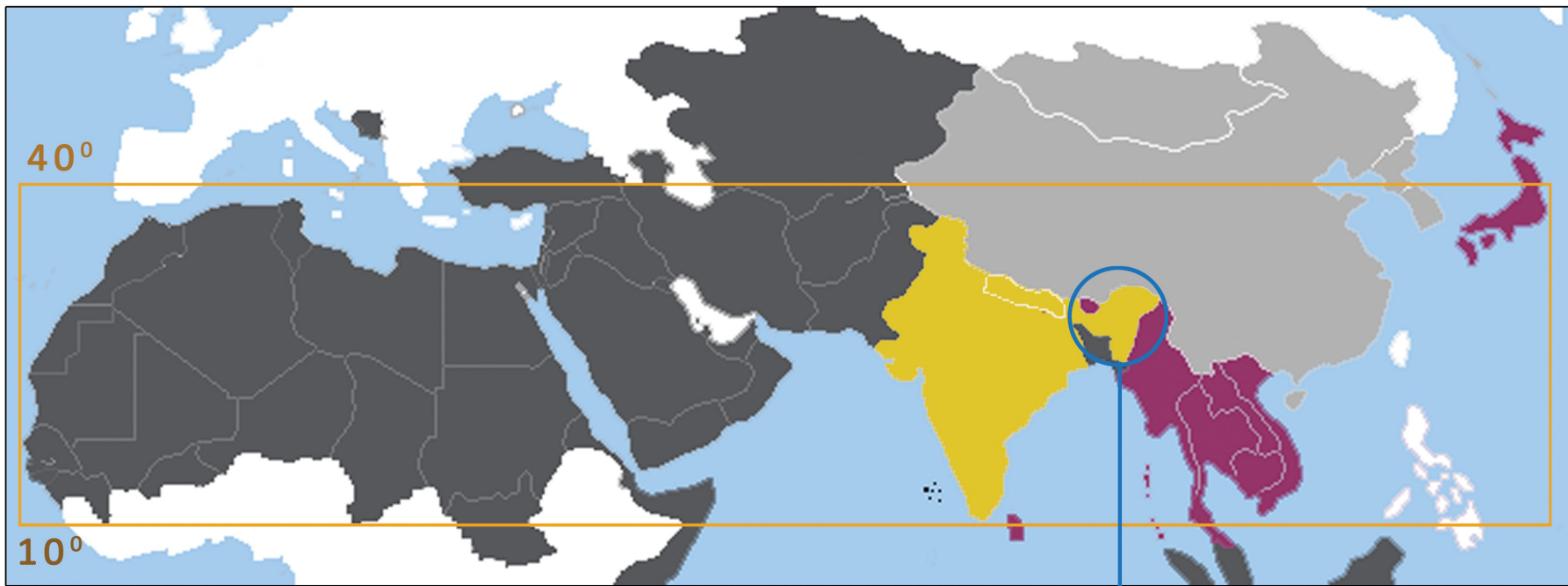
OBJECTIVES

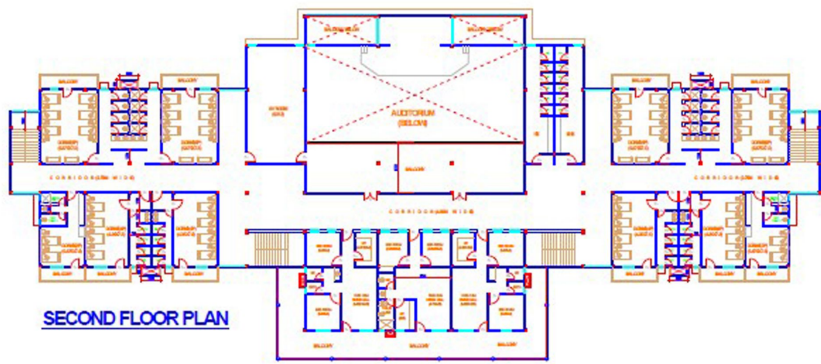

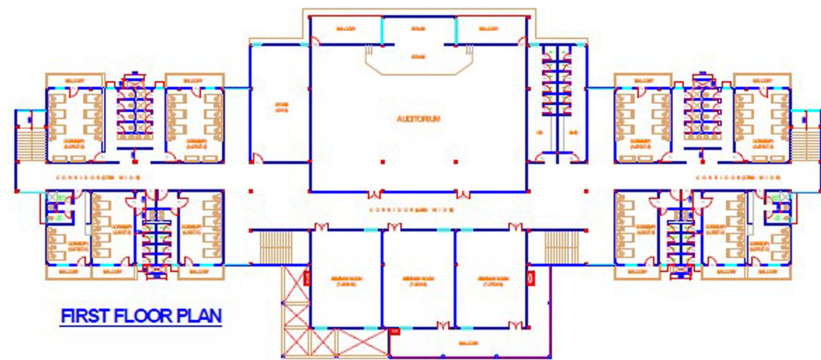

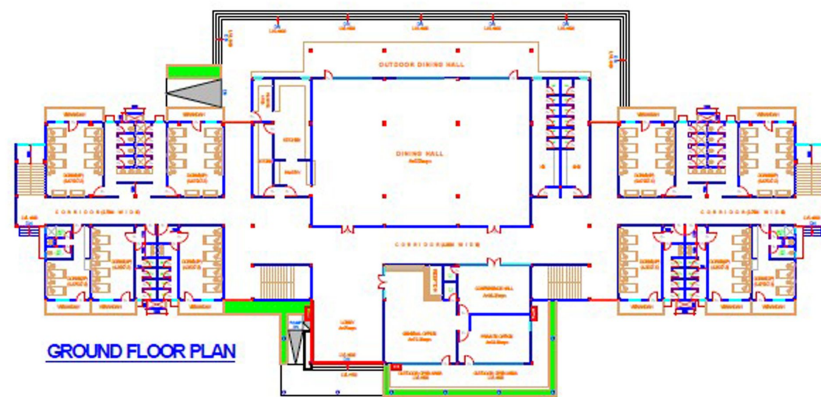

TLA will actively equip, encourage, and empower Christian leaders for the furtherance of the Kingdom of God in Asia.

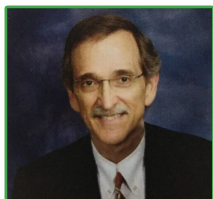
