OBJECTIVES

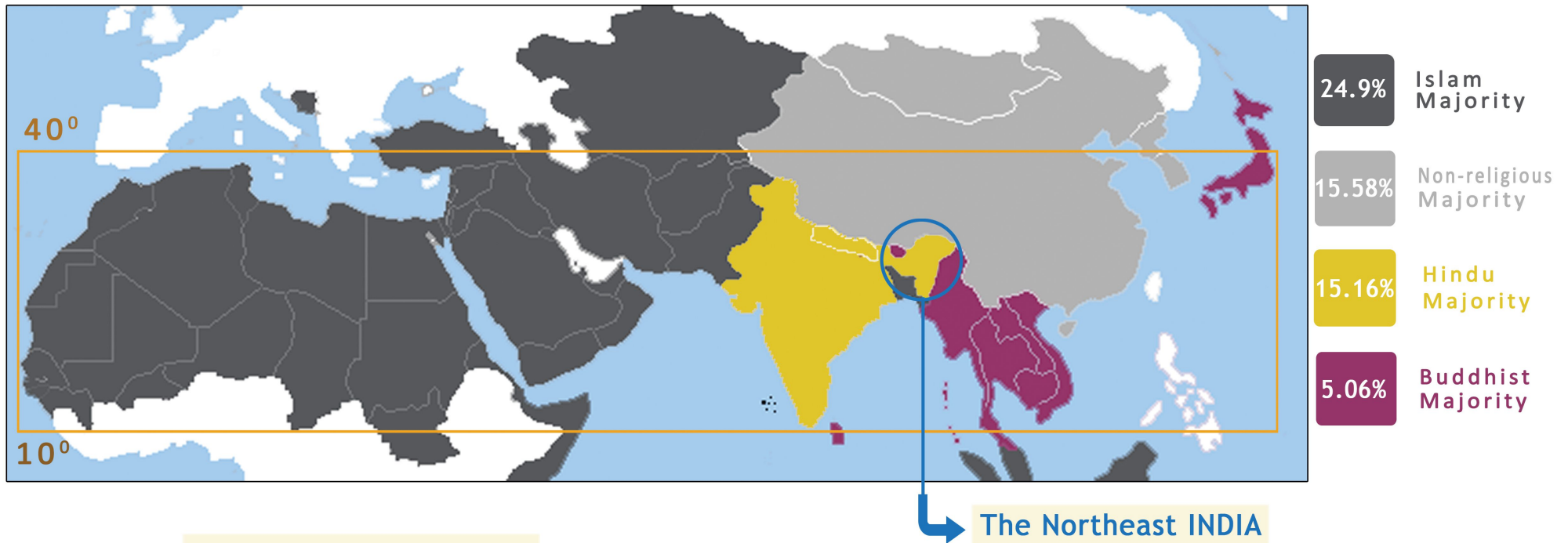
- Provide informal practical ministry skills training to missionaries, pastors, and leaders to enhance their effectiveness.

The city of Guwahati is a doorway to the seven states of Northeast India, bordering Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, China, and Thailand. Other neighboring countries are Sri Lanka, Nepal, and Pakistan. It can become an Epicenter of Missions in South-Central Asia serving a total of 4832 unreached people groups in the region [India (2373), Bangladesh (311), Bhutan (74), China (545), Myanmar (150), Nepal (269), Sri Lanka (161), Pakistan (835), Thailand (114)

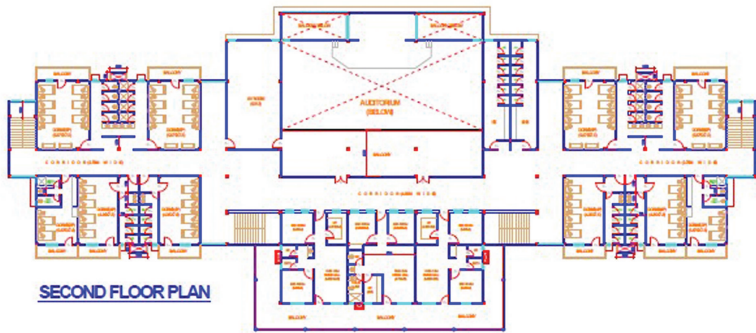

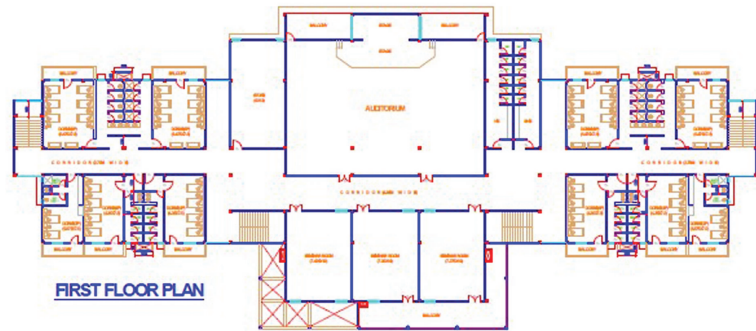

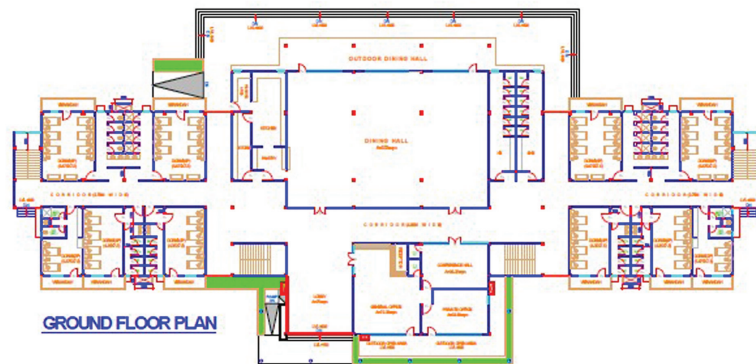
