1. One of the participants, a Hindu convert, was emotional on the last day. He said, *I have been Christian for last six years but no one mentored me the way TLA has done it.* One lady said, *I have done Counseling degree but I have now learned how to counsel and what to counsel.* We could also present Bible dictionaries, Commentaries, and Counseling books to some deserving participants.
