

Motorbike for the Spread of Gospel



On Dec 4, 2009, TLA Ministries distributed 4 (four) more motorbikes to the native Christian workers from Arunachal Pradesh and Assam. A small dedication ceremony was conducted at CBCNEI, Mission Compound, Guwahati, during which Mr. Jim Thomason, Chairman TLA Ministries handed over the motorbike

keys to the beneficiaries. The beneficiaries were:

1. **Atul Gogoi** belongs to Assamese community and has been spreading the Word of God in Dhemaji (Assam) since 2005 and he is being supported by CBCNEI. Traveling by bicycle, he helped more than 200 people to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.



2. **Nokthom Wangsu** belong Wangso tribe from the state of Arunachal Pradesh. He was prosecuted many times by his tribesmen and on one occasion he narrowly escaped his death. He has been in the ministry for last 14 years and during his ministry. He walks for 50 – 60 kms a day. He was delighted to received the Bike

3. **Honman Wangjen** is working as an evangelist among his Wangcho tribe in Arunachal Pradesh. He has been doing his ministry in the remote parts mostly by walking. He did not have any means for communication. He was very glad to receive a Bike.



4. **Tatung Taki** was born and brought up in a non-Christian family. Through a miraculous healing experience he surrendered his life to Christ to serve him as an evangelist in the remote part of Arunachal Pradesh. He had no any means of transportation. He is very encouraged to receive the Bike. Dr. Jerry Cain, President of Judson University, who was visiting CBCNEI prayed and dedicated the Bike.

Tatung returned to his mission field with happy heart.
